duction capacity of 15 MW/year reached 60 MW/year in just three years. Today Solarday employs about 140 people, all working at Mezzago, in the heart of Lombardy, with a turnover of approximately € 61 million in 2009.

Solarday, which is ISO 9001-2008 and OHSAS 18001-2008 certified, manufactures highly reliable superior quality products through avant-garde production processes, a cutting edge system of industri-

al devices and the cooperation of highly specialised technical staff dedicated to both product and process research and development.

To produce its photovoltaic modules, Solarday makes use of the latest generation of automated machinery, the most advanced in the photovoltaics sector. This technology results from consolidated partnerships with leading European companies that combine high quality standards and rapid processing times. Besides, there is also constant control of operating procedures on the part of specialised Solarday staff, and this endows the product with very high quality and reliability standards. Moreover, processing methods envisage the application of precise measuring systems to guarantee the quality of photovoltaic cells introduced into the production process and to ensure the exact wattage of the photovoltaic modules produced. This can guarantee a yield of min. 90 % from photovoltaic panels after 10 years, and min. 80 % after 25 years.

The products are there. The industry is growing. The culture too. „Made in Italy“ has become a trademark in the renewables sector. And Solarday is one of the companies which have paved the way for this development.
